**REQUESTED SERVICE:** Hearing Aids

**SERVICE DESCRIPTION:** Lions Hearing Center of Michigan (LHC) provides hearing screening, testing, analysis/fitting, and hearing aids to financially needy adults and children. LHC provides canal, behind the ear, and in the ear programmable aids. Aids come with a two year loss and damagewarranty. Patients can be seen at locations in Detroit, Southfield, Bloomfield Hills and throughout the state of Michigan. The program is a partnership with Lions Club districts 11-A1 and 11-A2, Wayne State University Department of Otolaryngology and the Detroit Medical Center.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Must have hearing impairment sufficient to warrant use of hearing aids. Must have an annual income of \$20,420 or less for one person or \$27,280 or less for two persons. Must submit a completed application including proof of income, provide a copy of a hearing test completed within the last year and a medical clearance form. Individuals with special needs who do not qualify within the low income requirements will be considered based on available resources.

**FEES:** None. Accepts Medicaid.
